Activity Report (2009-2023)

- Bhadreswar Netradarpan Welfare Foundation was established on 20th February 2009 with the primary objective of reducing blindness and addressing eye-related diseases.
- The foundation aligns its efforts with the National Program for Control of Blindness with Visual Impairment (NPCB&VI) and focuses on serving economically and socially disadvantaged rural and tribal communities.
- Regular eye screening and awareness camps are organized by the foundation in remote areas of West Bengal, reaching out to individuals who lack access to proper eye care services.
- The foundation plays a crucial role in arranging treatments for patients with eye diseases at its two tag hospitals, ensuring that those in need receive the necessary medical attention.
- A long-standing goal of the organization has been to establish an eye hospital that can serve as a dedicated base for executing their vision care initiatives more efficiently.
- In addition to providing medical services, the foundation uses street plays as a powerful tool to raise awareness about eye care practices and the importance of eye donation.
- Eye awareness movements are organized in various parts of the district, accompanied by seminars in schools and other important locations, to educate people about the significance of maintaining good eye health.
- The foundation has successfully organized numerous eye screening and awareness camps, receiving support from institutions such as RIO Kolkata and government offices, to provide essential eye care services to underserved communities.
- Special emphasis has been placed on addressing cataract cases, with the foundation facilitating free cataract surgeries at RIO Kolkata for those who cannot afford the treatment.
- To support the cause of eye donation, the foundation has established an Eye Collection Center at Bhadreswar, ensuring the efficient transportation of collected corneas to medical colleges in Kolkata.
- Despite the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, the foundation continued its services, performing over 2000 eye surgeries for socially and financially vulnerable individuals when traditional hospitals faced limitations.
- Active participation in the State Government's "Chokher Alo" program enabled the foundation to raise awareness about the importance of COVID-19 vaccination and dispel misconceptions among rural and tribal populations.
- Over the past three years itself, the foundation has organized more than 65 eye screening and awareness camps, providing much-needed check-ups and treatment for people in rural and tribal areas who otherwise lack access to proper eye care services.

Bhadreswar Netradarpan Welfare Foundation remains committed to its mission of bringing light and treatment to those in need, ensuring that no one is left behind when it comes to essential eye care.

Official order of Honourable District Magistrate

According to the official order of honourable District Magistrate, Bhadreswar Netradarpan Welfare Foundation is given the charge of clearing the huge backlog of patients suffering from eye diseases (specially Cataract) in the Chandannagar Subdivision, including the blocks of Singur, Haripal, Tarakeswar, Chandannagar Municipal Corporation, Bhadreswar Municipality, Champdani Municipality and Tarakeswar Municipality. The ordered copy is attached for your reference.

Following the order, to clear the huge backlog of patients, we are steadily conducting cataract surgeries at our base hospital 'Netradarpan Hospital' since its inauguration on 15th August, 2022 and we have conducted more than 500 cataract surgeries starting from the month of September, for patients who belong to the socially and economically weak class. We predict that we can reduce the backlog of the patients to a huge extent by the end of this year following the current trend.


